Thank you to all the people and businesses who provided a huge range of goods and services. Your generosity is incredible!

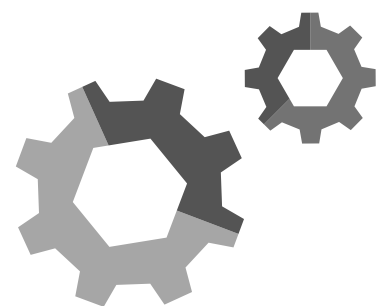

I love the way you expressed creativity when designing and creating your clay dragon eye. It looks absolutely magical!

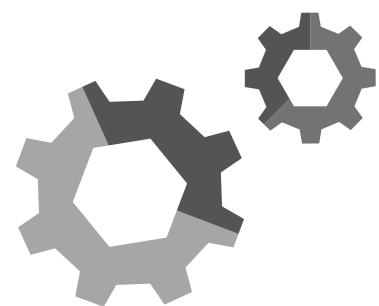
