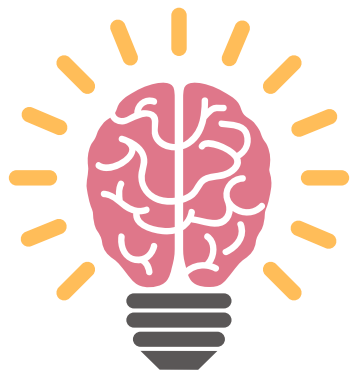


KUPU O TE WIKI

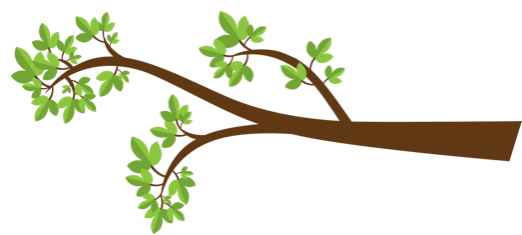

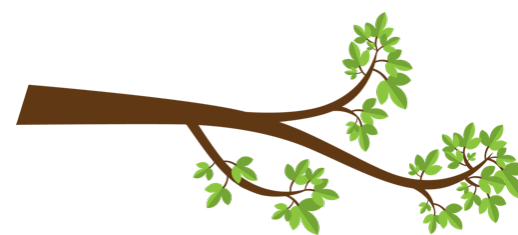
