CAR PARK SAFETY

We've recently reviewed our carpark safety procedures, and we are currently trialing a few new routines to help keep our Kaipaki tamariki safe as they enter and exit school. These include Ruma Tiwai Gate Monitors, who you may notice supporting students particularly in the afternoons.

We ask for your support please in ensuring tamariki are able to access the pedestrian crossing from drop off and pick up points. We know that parking can be tricky, particularly during peak times, but, we request that parking bays are utilised as much as possible. Stopping on the grass or on the pedestrian crossing can be unsafe and cause further congestion.

We are also aware that return trips to locate forgotten items, can often involve haste, and consequently, awareness of carpark safety can be overlooked. Please remind your children to return via the pedestrian crossing and to practice keeping themselves safe by checking for traffic before crossing.
