
#### **Welcome back Miss Pearce**





Ruma Rau recently put in great effort with report writing, which progressed into presenting speeches.




It was awesome to see all the students stepping up to the challenge of presenting their work in front of their peers, honing in on all the elements that make a speech presentation shine.















Ruma Rau work in tandem with Ruma Tiwai, providing library services to our reading tamariki.













### **ELECTIVES**


